tour so you can actually experience the design and functionality of the landscape around you.

Even before work starts, using a combination of paper plans, laptop and iPad, Teresa is able to show homeowners their future garden and how it will appear. In one project, having identified the ideal positioning of a sitting area that would catch the evening

high on the moors, Teresa was faced with a blank canvas – a site that was nothing more than a muddy building site.

After a detailed analysis, identifying opportunities and restrictions within the site and assessing which zones of the garden needed pathways for practicality, plans were drawn up and mood boards created.
